### **GROWTH**

- Registration grew to 936 this past season from 848 in 2019-2020 (8.6%)
- 45 Jr Inferno Teams from U7 (Timbits) to U18 (Midget)
- 5 Calgary Fire teams; 2xU15 AA (Bantam); 2xU18 AA, 1xAAA (Midget)
- Total Coaches 302
- Elite Coaches 20
- Managers and Team Support 152

### **OPERATIONS**

- This season, safety was the first priority. All safety measures implemented were due to the hard work of the Health and Safety coordinators. Thank you to all families who supported the safety policies.
- Evaluations committee have already been working for next season's evaluations.

### SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- Awarded tenancy at Father David Bauer (FDB) Olympic Arena by the City for our Calgary Fire AAA team
- Celebrated 30th Anniversary of our association with an opening ceremony at the AAA Home Opener, honoring members of the 1989-90 Peewee Cougars hockey team.
- Introduced 46 new participants to hockey through the inaugural Jr Inferno First Strides Program.
- Hosted another successful "Try Hockey Day" and "Try Goalie Day"

### COMMUNITY (JR INFERNO)

- Development Season: players were sorted into large cohorts.
- Competitive Season: A majority of member associations voted to shift to a competitive season. GHC advised against this. Due to the high number of Covid cases, this season came to a halt.
- Virtual Training. During the pause of the competitive season, the GHC development team organized an incredible schedule of virtual training sessions from mid-December to mid-Jan for all community players.
- Winter Skills: When play started after the pause, GHC offered 407 skaters and goalies U7-U18 a chance to participate in the winter skills program from February 22 to April 1, 2021.
- After the completion of the winter skills program, the development team will be looking to focus on more skills development.

### ELITE (CALGARY FIRE)

- GHC was able to run the prep and tryout camps under Hockey Alberta and provincial regulations.
- 108 tried out for U18, 100+ players tried out for U15.
- Teams were able to engage in exhibition games under AHS restrictions up to November 21, 2021.
- Elite teams trained together until February 2, 2021.
- AFHL season officially ended March 2021.

### Next season:

- GHC will request to extend our successful bid to host the 2019/2020 ATB Hockey Alberta U18 Female AAA provincial championships to the 2021/2022 tournament.
- 4 out 5 Fire coaches have committed to return to coach for the 2021/2022 season.
- Will host Spring ID camps for U15AA and U18 AAA/AA teams in June 2021 under the new AHS restrictions – City of Calgary will not release ice until they receive AHS approval.

### 4. SEASON FORECAST

### GHC OFFICE RELOCATION

- GHC will be relocating their office and storage to Great Plains under contract with the Canadian Female Sports Development Association (CFSDA).
- Goal is to make Great Plains the centre for female ice sports in Calgary
- With this move, we were able to consolidate storage from ECTAS and Max Bell to Great Plains.
- GHC still plans to maintain significant ice contracts with ECTAS.
- New location will not change our consideration and service to members throughout zone 9.
- Will still maintain storage and dressing room at Father David Bauer.
- Partnership with CFSDA aligns wil GHC's mission to increase visibility of female athletes.

### 5. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Jarid Poissant presented the GHC financial report for the 2020/21 season ending April 30, 2021. We have two main sources of revenue – registration fees and casinos. Community and Elite teams are budgeted independently, and each program is self-sufficient. Jarid highlighted items from the financial statements provided. Overall, cash position looks a little inflated due to refunds that were not cashed out as families chose to keep it in GHC and they will be applied to registration fees next season. Goal for this years financials was to be close to flat, and the final numbers reflect this.
